- In person appearance at the Embassy/ Consulate
- Once the documents have been submitted at the ICAC, VFS will liaise with the
  respective consular post and arrange for an in-person appointment for the

- Will of a dead person will not be attested at the Embassy/Consulate.
- Will of a mentally incapacitated person will not be accepted. Such cases will be entertained only if the applicant has notarized judicial orders of guardianship of the person who is the main executor of the Will.
